GUIDELINE FOR OBTAINING ROAD WORTHINESS CERTIFICATE

In pursuant of the mandate of the Yobe State Revenue (Codification) Law 2021

STEP 1

Vehicle owner presents for vehicle and vehicle documents for inspection at the Motor Vehicle Inspector's Office of the Yobe State Internal Revenue Service, Revenue House, Ahmadu Bello Way, Damaturu.

The following vehicle documents are required:

- 1. Number plate approval
- 2. Vehicle licence
- 3. Insurance certificate

STEP 2: Assessment and inspection of vehicle:

Vehicle Inspection Officer assess and inspects the vehicle and the documents listed in step 1 above.

Inspection advises applicant to proceed to payment if the vehicle is deemed fit for the road.

Timeline: 1 day

STEP 3: Payment of applicable fees as captured in the Yobe State Revenue (Codification) Law 2021 and listed below for ease of reference:

1	Road worthiness Certificate (Light and Buses)	1,250
2	Road worthiness Certificate (Heavy Goods Vehicles)	3,750

Kindly pay applicable fees to the Yobe State Internal Revenue Service account number 1010987086 with Zenith Bank Plc.

STEP 4: Approval and issuance of road worthiness certificate

Vehicle owner presents evidence of payment at the Motor Vehicle Inspector's Office located within the premises of Yobe State Internal Revenue Service, Revenue House, Ahmadu Bello Way, Damaturu.

Certificate of road worthiness is stamped, signed and issued to the applicant by VIO.
